Hirofumi Matsuo (co- Chair) (Tokyo International University, Japan)
– JOMSA Past President

Professor of Operations Management at Tokyo International University (TIU), and is its Director of both the Institute for International Strategy and the Institute for Data Science Education. He obtained his Ph.D. from MIT in 1984. He held Fred H. Moore Centennial Professorship at the University of Texas at Austin in 1997-1999 and Professor at Kobe University until 2020. He is Emeritus Professor of Kobe University. He studies supply chain management of high-tech and retailing industries as well as production planning and scheduling. His recent research interests include supply chain resilience, servitization, and digital platforms in manufacturing. He is the Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Japanese Operations Management and Strategy.

Past publishing includes several books and many papers related to supply chain management, strategic management and System Dynamics.

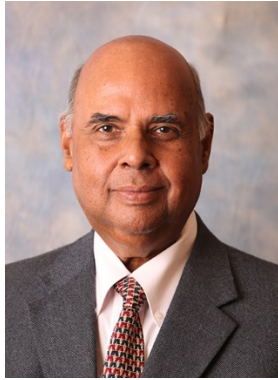
Nigel Caldwell (*London Metropolitan University, UK*)- *EurOMA Former Events Committee Chair.*

Nigel Caldwell is a Professor of Operations and Supply Management at London Metropolitan University, London, UK. Prior to joining London Met, Nigel worked as Director of the Logistics Research Centre at Heriot Watt University. Prior to that he worked as a Research Fellow at the University of Bath (CRiSPS/IDO), where he bid for and ran EPSRC funded projects. Nigel's research focuses on business to business relationships, performance and social value. He was a co-founder of the British Academy of Management's Special interest group in Inter-Organisational Relations, and a committee member of IPSERA, the International Purchasing and Supply Educational Research Association. He is an active member of the Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport. Nigel hosted EurOMA 2017, and has published widely in international journals such as, IJOPM, JMS, BJM and JOM



Gerald Reiner (*Vienna University of Economics and Business- Austria*) *EurOMA Former Events Committee member*

Full professor in Operations Management at the institute of Production Management, head of the institute for Production Management, academic director of the MSc Supply Chain Management as well as deputy head of the department for information systems and operations management at Vienna University of Economics and Business (Austria). In 2015 he was chair of the 22nd EurOMA conference in Neuchâtel, Switzerland and in 2016 he was the scientific conference program chair of the 5th World Conference on Productions and Operations Management P&OM in Havana, Cuba. He has taught at University of Delhi, India, and at University of North Carolina, U.S.A. Dr. Gupta has also served FIU as Vice Provost, Academic Affairs, and Associate Dean, College of Engineering. Dr. Gupta is an honorary professor at Universidad Ricardo Palma, Lima, Peru. Dr. Gupta is a highly esteemed scholar in the field of Production and Operations Management. His research interests include disaster management, healthcare, mathematical modeling, project management, supply chain management, and e-business. He has published in top-ranking professional journals including POM, MS, IIE-T, EJOR, IJPR, Omega, CIE, SEPS. He has also written several books on Production and Operations Management. Dr. Gupta is one of the founding members of POMS serving as Vice President and President in the past, and currently as its Executive Director. He is also a POMS Fellow. In addition, he serves on the advisory board of Production and Operations Management. Dr. Gupta has been the recipient of many prestigious research and teaching awards.
